RE: Beaufort Hill Primary School and works to the old Pen y Cwm Special School

Blaenau Gwent Education Department would like to update you on a project that will be undertaken over the summer holiday and further into the new academic year in September 2025 that may affect Beaufort Hill School.

Funding has been secured via education to demolish the old Pen y Cwm school site and the demountable unit in Beaufort Hill's play yard. This will take place from the middle of August until the second week of October 2024.

To allow these works to commence, the contractors will set up their site office and compound in a small part of the old Pen y Cwm carpark. This may cause some issues if parent/carers take their children to school by car in September, this is a temporary measure to allow these works to conclude on time.

The longer-term plan is for the Education Transformation team to support Beaufort Hill Primary school in acquiring the land for their use and to secure additional funding (subject to availability) to support the community ethos the school is creating. This may lead to potential building work in the near future being undertaken and creating additional space and community use areas.
