Changes to ALN Implementation Timeframe

The Minister for Education and Welsh Language has announced the decision to extend the implementation period of the ALN Act from three years to four years.

This means that children who were due to move to the ALN system between September 2023 and August 2024, will now move to the ALN system between September 2023 and August 2025.

The rights for children, and their parents, to request a child moves to the ALN system is unaffected – meaning that children who want to move to the ALN system can still ask to do so.
